

Rocky Mountain Emergency Services Training Center
 The area of the facility used for our event (including the track, pits, & grid) is approximately 31 acres.

Entrance Gate will be staffed to limit access to agreed # of attendees.

Track Facility has a full perimeter fence (black outline) & is only accessible by passing through one of two gates. One gate services the Emergency Dispatchers' building. The other accesses the track.

Drivers (limited to 150 total drivers for the event) are separated into 3 groups of 50 each throughout the 6 Session Race Day.

During each session, these groups are in different areas of the facility.

Within the groups, they are also separated.
 While Racing, the drivers stay with their cars between runs.
 While Resting, the drivers remain in the pits.
 While Working, the drivers are spaced out around the track, prepared to return displaced cones to their marked location, & to red flag a driver if needed. The purple lines outline the track area for this event.

Red Outline = Competitor Parking (PITS)
 Blue Outline = Spectator Parking (limited to # within event limit remaining after drivers have been checked in)
 Ex: If we are allowed 250 on site, & 185 drivers & family members are checked in, then only 65 spectators will be allowed on the site.
 Spectators will be asked to remain in the marked spectator area.
